ANTHONY MUÑOZ FOUNDATION PROGRAMS AND EVENTS

PROGRAMS

- **Youth Leadership Seminar** – Up to 100 Tri-State schools and 1,000 high schoolers join for a daylong seminar about reaching their goals and becoming leaders. Each year, YLS incorporates a theme and local leaders speak to students pertaining to the theme.
- **Straight 'A' Scholarship** – This scholarship awards high school students who are pursuing Academic Excellence and Athletic Achievement, are Actively serving in the community while possessing strong Ambition, have a winning Attitude, and the ability overcome Adversity.
- **Scholarship Fund** – Developed through Anthony and his family's passion to help deserving students reach their dreams of attending a local college or university, the Foundation's Scholarship Fund awards multiple \$20,000 scholarships to select Tri-State high school seniors.
- **Whiz Kids** – Each week during the school year, Foundation staff and volunteer tutors provide Kindergarten through 4th grade students at Roberts Academy with one-on-one mentoring and reading instruction.
- **Unplugged** – The Foundation started Unplugged, an extension program for 5th through 8th grade students who aged out of the Whiz Kids curriculum. Aligning with Cincinnati Public School initiatives, AMF works with these students weekly on Social and Emotional Learning competencies, high school preparation, future career exploration and service learning.
- **Impact for Eternity Camp** – Handpicked by partnering organizations and schools, up to 150 5th – 8th at risk grade boys to impact them mentally, spiritually, and physically. We teach social and emotional learning skills, as well as character development.
- **Football Academy** – More than 500 3rd – 8th grade boys and girls for a two-day camp with Anthony, 40 coaches to learn how to be successful on and off the field. In addition to football skills and techniques, character education, leadership and teamwork are all integral skills campers will take home.
- **Hispanic Character Camp** – Utilizing football as a platform, up to 150 5th through 8th grade Hispanic boys come to camp to experience a life-changing weekend full of Social and Emotional competency learning, character education, teamwork, and enriching activities, free of charge.

EVENTS

- **Hall of Fame Dinner** – Our biggest fundraiser of the year, where we invite nearly 500 of our partners to The Hall of Fame Dinner, presented by Furniture Fair, which includes a silent auction, and an impactful program celebrating our Scholarship Fund and Straight 'A' Scholarship recipients.
- **Hall of Fame Golf Classic** – Presented by Cincinnati Bell and held at the prestigious TPC River's Bend, the Golf Classic fundraiser features dozens of celebrity golfers paired with golf foursomes, all competing for the bragging rights that go along with our traveling trophy. The Foundation also invites military veterans to a complimentary spectator hole. The day is rounded out with tee prize packages, hole contests and a catered awards dinner.
- **Topgolf Tailgate** – The Foundation's annual Topgolf Tailgate is held each year to 'Tee off for the NFL Kickoff!' Partners and Friends of the Foundation come to Topgolf for dinner, drinks, golf, giveaways and of course, a great time!

Through deploying a life-changing college scholarship fund program, three high school education and recognition programs, three empowering football camps, and our Whiz Kids tutoring program, the Anthony Muñoz Foundation is making a tangible difference in the lives of youth across the Tri-State.

Anthony strongly feels that youth need to be encouraged and inspired, as well as recognized and rewarded for their accomplishments. Anthony and our organization want the youth of our region to know that they have value. No matter the odds, they can rise above the hardship's life has dealt them and achieve their dreams.

HOW DID THE FOUNDATION START?

An accomplished community icon, former Cincinnati Bengal and member of the Pro Football Hall of Fame Anthony Muñoz has been actively involved in his commitment to make a difference in the lives of local youth in the Greater Cincinnati region. Anthony decided to bring all his charitable initiatives together in April of 2002 to establish the Anthony Muñoz Foundation (AMF), a non-profit organization armed with the mission of engaging the Tri-State region to impact youth mentally, physically, and spiritually.
